## FAQ's:

### Where do the students come from?

We have hosted students from Japan, Korea, Brazil, France, Germany, Spain, Thailand, Italy, Portugal, Austria and Luxembourg.

### How old are the students?

Students are typically aged from 14-16 years.

### What support do I get from the school?

We have information sessions for host families before each study tour, where host families will receive profiles of their student, copies of school program, and detailed information regarding the study tour.

Host families will be paid a weekly amount to help support the visit. This is usually around \$270 for each student.

You will also have continual support from our International Team, and International Education Services (IES)

### How do I become a host family?

You will need to complete a Study Tour application form. These are available from our school. Each member living in your home over the age of 18 years requires a DCSI Police check, which is paid for by our school. Once this is completed, one of our team will contact you to arrange a home visit.
